Redesignated 16 February 1951 as the 31st Mobile Army Surgical Hospital and activated in Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1953 as the 31st Surgical Hospital

Reorganized and redesignated 29 December 1972 as the 31st Combat Support Hospital

Reorganized and redesignated 17 August 1992 as the 131st Field Hospital

Reorganized and redesignated 16 February 1996 as the 31st Combat Support Hospital
