Inactivated 24 October 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 27 September 1951 as the 165th Orthopedic Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 24 January 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 6 April 1966 as the 165th Medical Detachment

Activated 1 July 1966 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 25 July 1966 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Activated 2 February 1968 in Thailand

Inactivated 10 November 1970 in Thailand

Activated 16 July 2007 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina


