Redesignated 6 April 1945 as the 219th Malaria Survey Detachment

Inactivated 15 April 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 27 September 1951 as the 219th Preventive Medicine Survey Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 16 November 1951 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1953 as the 219th Medical Detachment

Inactivated 2 May 1955 in Korea

Activated 8 January 1968 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 16 February 1970 in Vietnam


