Activated 20 June 1942 at Camp Livingston, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 5 September 1945 as the 248th Medical Detachment

Inactivated 28 February 1946 in Egypt

Activated 1 August 1946 at Fort Glenn, Alaska

Inactivated 23 August 1948 at Cape Air Force Base, Alaska

Redesignated 27 September 1951 as the 248th Surgical Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 24 January 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 21 June 1976 as the 248th Medical Detachment and activated at Fort Jackson, South Carolina
