Constituted 6 November 1942 in the Organized Reserves as Company C, 331st Medical Regiment

Activated and ordered into active military service 10 December 1942 at Camp McCain, Mississippi

Reorganized and redesignated 7 October 1943 as the 469th Medical Collecting Company

Inactivated 24 November 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Activated 18 June 1947 at Kansas City, Kansas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps)

Location changed 19 April 1948 to Great Bend, Kansas

Inactivated 19 September 1950 at Great Bend, Kansas

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 16 June 1980 as the 469th Medical Company and activated at Wichita, Kansas

Ordered into active military service 14 August 2011 at Wichita, Kansas; released from active military service 16 September 2012 and reverted to reserve status
