Activated 15 February 1945 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 20 October 1945 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Redesignated 15 November 1950 as the 541st Thoracic Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 5 January 1950 at Denver, Colorado

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 5 September 1952 at Denver, Colorado

Redesignated 26 November 1966 as the 541st Medical Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 February 1967 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 20 March 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 March 2006 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
