Activated 16 November 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 24 January 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 30 October 1962 as the 75th Medical Detachment

Activated 1 November 1962 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

Inactivated 1 October 1970 in Vietnam

Activated 21 June 1976 at Fort Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 15 September 1992 at Fort Meade, Maryland
