Lineage and Honors

801st COMBAT SUPPORT HOSPITAL

Constituted in July 1923 in the Organized Reserves as the 28th Station Hospital

Organized 20 November 1937 at Buffalo, New York

Ordered into active military service 4 May 1942 and reorganized at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 2 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 4 September 1947 as the 801st Station Hospital

Activated 1 October 1947 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 November 1950 at Chicago, Illinois

Redesignated 27 May 1952 as the 801st General Hospital

Activated 1 July 1952 at Chicago, Illinois

Location changed about 1990 to Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1995 as the 801st Combat Support Hospital

Ordered into active military service 24 February 2003 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois; released from active military service 24 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status

(Element ordered into active military service 28 February 2011 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois;
released from active military service 21 January 2012 and reverted to reserve status)


