Redesignated 18 April 1967 as the 86th Evacuation Hospital

Activated 1 August 1967 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky

Reorganized and redesignated 21 December 1972 as the 86th Combat Support Hospital

Reorganized and redesignated 16 March 1984 as the 86th Evacuation Hospital

Reorganized and redesignated 16 November 1993 as the 86th Combat Support Hospital
