Constituted 13 February 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 915th Veterinary Food Inspection Detachment

Activated 25 February 1945 in China

Inactivated 23 October 1945 in China

Redesignated 30 July 1965 as the 915th Medical Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 11 August 1965 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

Inactivated 1 December 1969 in Vietnam

Allotted 16 February 1998 to the Army Reserve and activated at Vancouver, Washington

Ordered into active military service 24 January 2003 at Vancouver, Washington; released from active military service 23 January 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 6 August 2009 at Vancouver, Washington; released from active military service 9 September 2010 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 23 September 2013 at Vancouver, Washington
