Activated 8 January 1945 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 25 March 1946 in the Philippines

Allotted 30 June 1947 to the Organized Reserve Corps

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 11 July 1947 at Kingsville, Texas

Inactivated 8 March 1950 at Kingsville, Texas

Redesignated 16 September 1987 as the 987th Medical Detachment and activated at San Diego, California

Inactivated 15 February 1993 at San Diego, California

Activated 16 September 2011 at Ogden, Utah


