Constituted 30 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 547th Platoon (Separate) Ship Hospital

Redesignated 1 March 1943 as the 547th Medical Hospital Ship Platoon

Activated 25 February 1943 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Inactivated 29 September 1945 at Fort Hamilton, New York

Redesignated 25 March 1948 as the 993d Medical Hospital Ship Platoon and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 28 April 1948 at Springfield, Ohio

Inactivated 19 October 1950 at Springfield, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 16 September 1987 as the 993d Medical Detachment and activated at Aurora, Colorado

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Aurora, Colorado; released from active military service 3 June 2005

(Element ordered into active military service 9 November 2008 at Aurora, Colorado; released from active military service 13 December 2009)
