Constituted 5 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 548th Platoon Ship Hospital

Activated 25 February 1943 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Redesignated 3 March 1943 as the 548th Medical Hospital Ship Platoon, Separate

Inactivated 20 November 1945 at Camp Anza, California

Redesignated 19 April 1948 as the 994th Medical Hospital Ship Platoon, Separate, and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 28 April 1948 at Mansfield, Ohio

Inactivated 31 January 1950 at Mansfield, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 16 September 1987 as the 994th Medical Detachment and activated at Austin, Texas

(Elements ordered into active military service 13 November 2001-28 July 2003 at Austin, Texas; released from active military service 2002 -29 July 2004 and reverted to reserve status)

Location changed 16 February 2004 to Round Rock, Texas

(Element ordered into active military service 11 January 2007 at Round Rock, Texas; released from active military service 9 May 2008 and reverted to reserve status)

Ordered into active military service 31 March-19 April 2011 at Round Rock, Texas; released from active military service 17 April -3 May 2012 and reverted to reserve status
