Activated 15 June 1942 at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Disbanded 28 January 1945 in France

Reconstituted 1 October 1991 in the Regular Army

Activated 16 September 1992 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Reorganized 16 August 2002 to consist of Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 261st Medical Battalion (organic elements concurrently inactivated)
