# 138th MILITARY INTELLIGENCE COMPANY

Constituted 1 June 1966 in the Regular Army as the 138th Aviation Company and activated in Vietnam

Inactivated 1 March 1973 in Vietnam

Redesignated 15 April 1974 as the 138th Army Security Agency Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army, allotted to the Army Reserve, and activated at Orlando, Florida

Ordered into active military service 11 October 1990 at Orlando, Florida; released from active military service 5 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 1995 as the 138th Military Intelligence Company

Inactivated 15 April 1999 at Orlando, Florida

Activated 16 October 2004 at Robins Air Force Base, Georgia
