Inactivated 1 March 1953 at Chicago, Illinois

Redesignated 28 March 1996 as Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, 378th Military Intelligence Battalion (organic elements concurrently constituted)

Battalion activated 16 September 1997 with Headquarters at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Inactivated 15 June 1999 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Activated 16 September 2005 with Headquarters at Fort Sheridan, Illinois


