Activated 1 July 1965 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 20 November 1968 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 1 February 1974 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve; concurrently redesignated as the 406th Army Security Agency Company and activated at Bell, California

Inactivated 15 July 1986 at Bell, California

Redesignated 16 September 1992 as the 406th Military Intelligence Company and activated at Phoenix, Arizona

Location changed 1 September 1994 to Mesa, Arizona

Inactivated 15 September 1997 at Mesa, Arizona

Withdrawn 4 February 1999 from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 16 June 2000 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii
