Activated 15 January 1953 in Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 20 October 1953 as the 513th Military Intelligence Group

Redesignated 25 July 1961 as the 513th Intelligence Corps Group

Redesignated 15 October 1966 as the 513th Military Intelligence Group

Inactivated 25 June 1969 in Germany

Redesignated 2 October 1982 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 513th Military Intelligence Group, and activated at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1986 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 513th Military Intelligence Brigade

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1991 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 513th Military Intelligence Brigade

Reorganized and redesignated 16 November 1995 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 513th Military Intelligence Brigade
