Lineage and Honors

102d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 102d Military Police Company and assigned to the 102d Division

Redesignated 30 January 1942 as the Military Police Platoon, Headquarters and Military Police Company, 102d Division

Redesignated 15 September 1942 as the Military Police Platoon, 102d Infantry Division; concurrently ordered into active military service and activated at Camp Maxey, Texas

Inactivated 12 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 1 November 1946 as the 102d Military Police Company, an element of the 102d Infantry Division

Activated 14 November 1946 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

Inactivated 3 January 1947 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

Activated 31 January 1947 at St. Louis, Missouri

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 May 1959 at St. Louis, Missouri

Activated 1 April 1963 at St. Louis, Missouri

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at St. Louis, Missouri, and relieved from assignment to the 102d Infantry Division

102d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Activated 15 April 1976 at Kansas City, Missouri

Location changed 1 February 1981 to Richards-Gebaur Air Force Base, Missouri; on 16 October 1982 to Belton, Missouri

Inactivated 15 September 1990 at Belton, Missouri

Activated 16 September 2011 at Sheboygan, Wisconsin

Ordered into active military service 6 October 2014 at Sheboygan, Wisconsin; released from active military service 17 September 2015 and reverted to reserve status
