Constituted 24 April 1962 in the Missouri Army National Guard as Battery B, 3d Missile Battalion, 128th Artillery

Organized and Federally recognized 1 May 1962 at Lone Jack

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1966 as Battery B, 3d Battalion, 128th Artillery

Consolidated 1 March 1969 with Battery A, 3d Battalion, 128th Artillery (see ANNEX), and consolidated unit converted and redesignated as the 1139th Military Police Company

Location changed 1 May 1972 to Pleasant Hill

Ordered into active Federal service 31 May 1980 at Pleasant Hill; released from active Federal service 15 June 1980 and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 January 1988 to Harrisonville

Ordered into active Federal service 26 November 2001 at Harrisonville; released from active Federal service 1 October 2002 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 23 February 2003 at Harrisonville; released from active Federal service 23 February 2004 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 12 August 2009 at Harrisonville; released from active Federal service 15 September 2010 and reverted to state control
