1303d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 21 June 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 26th Military Police Criminal Investigation Section

Activated 26 June 1944 at Fort Custer, Michigan

Redesignated 20 April 1945 as the 26th Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment

Inactivated 31 May 1946 at Manila, Philippines

Redesignated 13 June 1947 as the 303d Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 21 June 1947 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1955 as the 303d Military Police Detachment

Inactivated 1 July 1959 at New York, New York

Withdrawn 26 October 1966 from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 3 November 1966 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 20 December 1968 in Thailand

Withdrawn 13 April 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

1303d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Redesignated 12 April 2018 as the 1303d Military Police Company

Activated 16 September 2020 at Chambersburg, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 5 May 2022 at Chambersburg, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 8 June 2023 and reverted to reserve status
