Constituted 31 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 29th Military Police Criminal Investigation Section

Activated 7 August 1944 at London, England

Reorganized and redesignated 29 December 1944 as the 29th Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment

Inactivated 20 October 1945 at Camp Bullis, Texas

Redesignated 13 June 1947 as the 304th Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 21 June 1947 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 1 December 1955 as the 304th Military Police Detachment

Inactivated 15 May 1959 at New York, New York

Withdrawn 26 October 1966 from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 3 November 1966 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 20 December 1968 in Thailand

Withdrawn 13 April 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve
