152d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Organized 22 November 1920 in the Alabama National Guard at Hartselle as Troop C, 109th Cavalry

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 July 1926 as Company C, 127th Engineer Combat Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1931 as Troop C, 127th Engineer Squadron

Redesignated 1 April 1936 as Troop C, 127th Squadron, Corps of Engineers

Redesignated 13 July 1936 as Troop C, 127th Engineer Squadron

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1940 as Company C, 1st Battalion, 151st Engineers

Inducted into Federal service 27 January 1941 at Hartselle

Redesignated 12 September 1942 as Company C, 1st Battalion, 151st Engineer Combat Regiment

Redesignated 11 January 1944 as Company C, 151st Engineer Combat Battalion

Inactivated 27 December 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Reorganized and Federally recognized 21 February 1947 in the Alabama National Guard at Hartselle as Company C, 1343d Engineer Combat Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 14 August 1950 at Hartselle

152d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

(Company C, 1343d Engineer Combat Battalion [NGUS] organized and Federally recognized 21 January 1953 at Hartselle; redesignated 1 February 1953 as Company C, 1343d Engineer Battalion [NGUS])

(1343d Engineer Combat Battalion redesignated 15 March 1954 as the 1343d Engineer Battalion)

Released from active Federal service 21 February 1955 and reverted to state control; Federal recognition concurrently withdrawn from Company C, 1343d Engineer Battalion (NGUS)

Ordered into active Federal service 11 June 1963 at Hartselle; released from active Federal service 16 June 1963 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 10 September 1963 at Hartselle; released from active Federal service 12 September 1963 and reverted to state control

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 1995 as Battery A, 1st Battalion, 203d Air Defense Artillery

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 2000 as Battery C, 1st Battalion, 203d Air Defense Artillery

Consolidated 1 March 2002 with Detachment 1 at Huntsville (organized and Federally recognized 29 July 1997) and consolidated unit designated as Battery C, 1st Battalion, 203d Air Defense Artillery

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 2005 as the 152d Military Police Company

Ordered into active Federal service 30 June 2006 at Hartselle; released from active Federal service 26 December 2007 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 23 June 2012 at Hartselle


