# **29th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY**

Constituted 23 May 1946 in the Maryland National Guard as the 29th Military Police Company and assigned to the 29th Infantry Division

Organized and Federally recognized 8 June 1948 at Baltimore

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 200th Military Police Battalion, and relieved from assignment to the 29th Infantry Division

Location changed 1 March 1963 to Towson; on 15 November 1964 to Baltimore

Reorganized and redesignated 21 January 1968 as the 29th Military Police Company; concurrently, location changed to Pikesville

Ordered into active Federal service 7 April 1968 at Pikesville; released 12 April 1968 from active Federal service and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 December 1974 to Phoenix; on 1 October 1981 to Towson

Redesignated 1 June 1986 as the 290th Military Police Company

Ordered into active Federal service 15 November 1990 at Towson; released from active Federal service 1 May 1991 and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 November 1996 to Nottingham

Ordered into active Federal service 11 September 2001 at Nottingham; released from active Federal service 30 September 2002 and reverted to state control

### 29th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Ordered into active Federal service 7 July 2003 at Nottingham; released from active Federal service 5 July 2004 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 23 October 2007 at Nottingham; released from active Federal service 25 November 2008 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 6 March 2013 at Nottingham; released from active Federal service 9 April 2014 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 September 2023 with 29th Military Police Company (see ANNEX) and Detachment 1, 290th Military Police Company (organized 15 November 2017); and consolidated unit designated 29th Military Police Company and location concurrently changed to Westminster

#### ANNEX

Organized and Federally recognized 1 July 1986 in the Maryland Army National Guard at Pikesville as the 29th Military Police Company

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2006 as Detachment 1, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 115th Infantry Regiment, and location changed to Hagerstown

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2012 as the 29th Military Police Company, and location changed to Westminster
