303d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 10 June 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 183d Military Police Company

Activated 29 June 1943 at Canastel, Algeria

Inactivated 16 June 1946 at Florence, Italy

Redesignated 16 May 1947 as the 303d Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 30 May 1947 at Atlanta, Georgia

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 12 May 1949 at Atlanta, Georgia

Activated 25 July 1949 at St. Louis, Missouri

Inactivated 18 December 1950 at St. Louis, Missouri

Activated 30 September 1976 at Jackson, Michigan

Ordered into active military service 21 October 2002 at Jackson, Michigan; released from active military service 20 October 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 10 September 2006 at Jackson, Michigan; released from active military service 7 March 2008 and reverted to reserve status
