Lineage and Honors

316th MILITARY POLICE DETACHMENT

Constituted 22 April 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 156th Military Police Composite Platoon

Activated 24 October 1944 at Bombay, India

Reorganized and redesignated 15 April 1945 as the 156th Military Police Guard Platoon

Inactivated 5 October 1945 at Chabua, India

Redesignated 27 October 1948 as the 316th Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment and assigned to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 17 November 1948 at Los Angeles, California

Ordered into active military service 8 October 1950 at San Francisco, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Released from active military service 1 November 1953 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 2 November 1953 to Pasadena, California

Reorganized and redesignated 14 March 1954 as the 316th Military Police Detachment

Location changed 10 April 1957 to Los Angeles, California

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Los Angeles, California;
released from active military service 19 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 19 August 1962 to Bell, California; on 30 September 1971 to Los Angeles, California; on 1 January 1982 to Bell, California

Ordered into active military service 1 August 2014 at Bell, California; released from active military service 31 July 2015 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 1 December 2020 at Bell, California; released from active military 4 January 2022 and reverted to reserve status
