Constituted 31 December 1941 in the Army of the United States as the 203d Military Police Company

Activated 10 January 1942 at San Bernardino, California

Inactivated 25 November 1945 at Wiesbaden, Germany

Redesignated 1 March 1948 as the 348th Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 March 1948 at Oakland, California

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 1 October 1950 to Sacramento, California

Inactivated 1 July 1959 at Sacramento, California

Activated 20 January 1968 at Bakersfield, California

Inactivated 15 September 1990 at Bakersfield, California

Activated 16 September 2008 at Ames, Iowa

Ordered into active military service 7 February 2012 at Ames, Iowa; released from active military service 12 March 2013 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 15 September 2021 to El Paso, Texas

Ordered into active military service 28 April 2022 at El Paso, Texas; released from active military service 1 June 2023 and reverted to state control
