Reorganized and redesignated 19 August 1954 as the 34th Military Police Detachment

Inactivated 24 March 1965 at Fort Knox, Kentucky

Activated 25 June 1965 in Germany

Inactivated 20 November 1977 in Germany

Activated 16 June 2001 at Fort Knox, Kentucky
