Constituted 10 June 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 190th Military Police Company

Activated 24 June 1943 at Berrechid, French Morocco

Inactivated 15 November 1945 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Redesignated 12 February 1948 as the 351st Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 27 February 1948 at New Orleans, Louisiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 December 1950 at New Orleans, Louisiana

Activated 1 February 1963 at Bogalousa, Louisiana

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Bogalousa, Louisiana

Activated 22 February 1972 at Ocala, Florida

Ordered into active military service 12 September 1990 at Ocala, Florida; released from active military service 15 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Ocala, Florida; released from active military service 16 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 30 November 2008 at Ocala, Florida; released from active military service 3 January 2010 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 8 May 2014 at Ocala, Florida; released from active military service 19 January 2015 and reverted to reserve status
