Constituted 3 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 214th Military Police Company

Activated 18 January 1943 at Camp Beauregard, Louisiana

Inactivated 13 February 1946 at Camp Polk, Louisiana

Redesignated 12 January 1948 as the 352d Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 21 January 1948 at Fort Worth, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 13 October 1950 at Fort Worth, Texas

Activated 30 December 1967 at Fort Worth, Texas

Inactivated 22 February 1972 at Fort Worth, Texas

Activated 16 April 1981 at Oakdale, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 6 December 1990 at Oakdale, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 8 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 June 1994 to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; on 18 September 1999 to Rockville, Maryland

Ordered into active military service 2 January 2008 at Rockville, Maryland; released from active military service 4 February 2009 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 22 March 2018 at Rockville, Maryland; released from active military service 21 March 2019 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 January 2023 at Rockville, Maryland; released from active military service 10 February 2024 and reverted to reserve status
