Lineage and Honors

354th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 13 April 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 137th Military Police Company

Activated 10 June 1944 on Corsica

Inactivated 5 November 1945 at Livorno, Italy

Redesignated 15 December 1947 as the 354th Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 31 December 1947 at Grand Rapids, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Grand Rapids, Michigan; released from active military service 10 March 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 18 March 1955 to Worthington, Minnesota; on 18 May 1959 to Rochester, Minnesota

Inactivated 22 February 1972 at Rochester, Minnesota

Activated 17 September 2008 at St. Louis, Missouri

Ordered into active military service 9 October 2009 at St. Louis; released from active military service 12 November 2010 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 11 April 2020 at St. Louis; released from active military service 15 May 2021 and reverted to reserve status
