Constituted 13 April 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 139th Military Police Company

Activated 1 June 1944 at Aversa, Italy

Inactivated 15 November 1945 at Cecina, Italy

Redesignated 31 July 1947 as the 357th Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 29 August 1947 at East Lansing, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 4 December 1950 at East Lansing, Michigan

Activated 31 January 1963 at Saginaw, Michigan

Inactivated 15 September 1990 at Saginaw, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2009 at Concord, California

Ordered into active military service 1 May 2013 at Concord, California; released from active military service 4 June 2014 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2018 at Concord, California; released from active military service 6 December 2019 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 15 September 2023 at Concord, California
