358th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 10 June 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 187th Military Police Company

Activated 24 June 1943 in Oran, Algeria

Inactivated 16 June 1946 in Rome, Italy

Redesignated 27 June 1947 as the 358th Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 17 July 1947 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 November 1950 at Chicago, Illinois

Activated 25 June 1953 at Decatur, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 6 December 1990 at Decatur, Illinois; released from active military service 30 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 December 1991 at Decatur, Illinois

Activated 16 September 2018 at Tustin, California

Ordered into active military service 2 January 2021 at Tustin, California; released from active military service 5 February 2022 and reverted to reserve status
