Constituted 30 December 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 361st Military Police Company

Activated 31 December 1944 in France

Inactivated 27 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Allotted 9 December 1946 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 December 1946 at Columbus, Ohio

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 19 September 1950 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 17 January 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 May 1955 to Cambridge, Ohio

Inactivated 1 May 1959 at Cambridge, Ohio

Activated 22 January 1968 at Dover, Ohio

Location changed 8 May 1971 to Canton, Ohio; on 25 August 1984 to North Canton, Ohio

Ordered into active military service on 6 December 1990 at North Canton, Ohio; released from active military service 4 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status
