362d MILITARY POLICE DETACHMENT

Constituted 13 January 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 362d Military Police Gate and Patrol Detachment

Activated 21 March 1945 in England

Redesignated 21 April 1945 as the 362d Military Police Patrol Detachment

Inactivated 15 October 1945 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Redesignated 27 July 1948 as the 362d Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 20 August 1948 at Oakland, California

Inactivated 30 November 1950 at Oakland, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 22 February 1972 as the 362d Military Police Detachment and activated at Fort Wayne, Indiana

Inactivated 1 October 1978 at Fort Wayne, Indiana

Activated 16 September 2003 at Ashley, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 15 December 2003 at Ashley, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 11 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 9 June 2010 at Ashley, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 13 July 2011 and reverted to reserve status
