Activated 31 December 1944 at Epinal, France

Inactivated 25 February 1946 at Aiea, Hawaii

Allotted 20 January 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 28 January 1947 at Charleston, West Virginia

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 9 August 1950 at Charleston, West Virginia

Activated 22 January 1968 at Grafton, West Virginia

Ordered into active military service 4 January 1991 at Grafton, West Virginia; released from active military service 8 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 26 November 2001-7 January 2002 at Grafton, West Virginia; released from active military service 2 November 2002 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 February 2003 at Grafton, West Virginia; released from active military service 4 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 25 July 2009 at Grafton, West Virginia; released from active military service 28 August 2010 and reverted to reserve status
