366th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 6 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 216th Military Police Company

Activated 1 March 1943 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 31 May 1946 at Kure, Japan

Redesignated 19 March 1948 as the 366th Military Police Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserves)

Activated 2 April 1948 at El Reno, Oklahoma

Location changed 1 February 1950 to Ponca City, Oklahoma; on 1 March 1952 to McAlester, Oklahoma

Inactivated 24 April 1953 at McAlester, Oklahoma

Activated 1 April 1996 at Stillwater, Oklahoma

Ordered into active military service 14 January 2002 at Stillwater, Oklahoma; released from active military service 13 January 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 29 April 2017 at Stillwater, Oklahoma; released from active military service 10 April 2018 and reverted to reserve status
