375th MILITARY POLICE DETACHMENT

Constituted 13 January 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 375th Military Police Gate and Patrol Detachment

Activated 21 March 1945 in England

Redesignated 21 April 1945 as the 375th Military Police Patrol Detachment

Inactivated 28 September 1945 at Camp Anza, California

Redesignated 28 September 1948 as the 375th Military Police Criminal Investigation Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 7 October 1948 at Baltimore, Maryland

Location changed 26 January 1950 to Cleveland, Ohio

Inactivated 9 August 1950 at Cleveland, Ohio

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 7 January 1963 as the 375th Military Police Detachment and activated at Columbus, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 3 October 2001 at Columbus, Ohio; elements released from active military service from 2 October 2002 to 2 October 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 9 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 15 December 2007 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 13 December 2008 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 2 May 2013 at Columbus, Ohio
