Constituted 25 September 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 377th Military Police Company

Activated 15 October 1942 at Florence, Arizona

Inactivated 6 November 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Allotted 16 June 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 16 July 1947 at Jackson, Mississippi

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 1 September 1950 at Jackson, Mississippi

Redesignated 31 March 1955 as the 377th Military Police Company and activated at Sanford, North Carolina

Inactivated 25 June 1959 at Sanford, North Carolina

Activated 1 March 1976 at Cincinnati, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 17 June 2002 at Cincinnati, Ohio; released from active military service 16 June 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 31 March 2010 at Cincinnati, Ohio; released from active military service 4 May 2011 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 3 July 2015 at Cincinnati, Ohio; released from active military service 5 August 2016 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 24 April 2020 at Cincinnati, Ohio; released from active military service 27 April 2020 and reverted to reserve status
