Constituted 1 January 1998 in the Missouri Army National Guard as Detachment 1, 2175th Military Police Company

Organized and Federally recognized 3 April 1998 at Fulton

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1999 as Detachment 3, 1137th Military Police Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 2000 as Detachment 2, 1137th Military Police Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2006 as the 1140th Military Police Company

Ordered into active Federal service 15 April 2009 at Fulton; released from active Federal service 19 May 2010 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 May 2011 with the 4175th Military Police Detachment (see ANNEX), and consolidated unit designated as the 4175th Military Police Detachment

Constituted 1 October 2005 in the Missouri Army National Guard as the 4175th Military Police Detachment

Organized and Federally recognized 7 November 2007 at Centertown


