Constituted 4 December 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 623d Military Police Company

Activated 2 January 1945 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Inactivated 30 September 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 7 June 1949 as the 422d Military Police Company, Post, Camp, or Station and allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 11 July 1949 at Watsonville, California

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1950 as the 422d Military Police Escort Guard Company; location concurrently changed to Fort Ord, California

Location changed 1 March 1951 to Santa Cruz, California

Reorganized and redesignated 16 December 1957 as the 422d Military Police Guard Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1959 as the 422d Military Police Company

Inactivated 29 February 1968 at Santa Cruz, California

Activated 16 September 2008 at Bakersfield, California


