**443d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY**

Constituted 10 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 443d Prisoner of War Processing Company

Activated 26 December 1942 at Camp Swift, Texas

Redesignated 3 April 1943 as the 443d Military Police Prisoner of War Processing Company

Inactivated 17 October 1945 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

Allotted 15 April 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 May 1947 at Providence, Rhode Island

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 27 January 1950 at Providence, Rhode Island

Redesignated 5 April 1955 as the 443d Military Police Company

Activated 6 April 1955 at Winooski, Vermont

Inactivated 30 June 1959 at Winooski, Vermont

Activated 1 April 1996 at Owings Mills, Maryland

Ordered into active military service 6 October 2001 at Owings Mills, Maryland; released from active military service 5 October 2002 and reverted to reserve status

## 443d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Ordered into active military service 24 February 2003 at Owings Mills, Maryland; released from active military service 23 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status.

Location changed 1 August 2005 to Sparks, Maryland; on 1 August 2009 to Owings Mills, Maryland


