Activated 20 May 1947 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1948 as the 512th Military Police Company

Allotted 25 October 1951 to the Regular Army

Inactivated 24 June 1955 in Korea

Activated 1 July 1956 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Inactivated 30 April 1983 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Activated 16 October 2008 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri


