Activated 18 March 1945 in the Philippines

Inactivated 15 June 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 12 August 1948 as the 558th Military Police Company

Activated 15 September 1948 in Japan

Allotted 19 November 1951 to the Regular Army

Inactivated 3 June 1955 in Korea

Activated 24 March 1962 in Germany

Inactivated 15 January 1992 in Germany

Activated 16 October 2008 at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii
