602d MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Constituted 10 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company A, 601st Military Police Battalion

Activated 26 December 1942 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

Inactivated 15 February 1946 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Redesignated 31 October 1955 as the 602d Military Police Company and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 1 November 1955 at Indianapolis, Indiana

Redesignated 7 June 1957 as the 602d Military Police Guard Company

Location changed 1 May 1959 to Detroit, Michigan; on 15 June 1959 to Dearborn, Michigan

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Dearborn, Michigan; released from active military service 15 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Redesignated 1 June 1963 as the 602d Military Police Company

Location changed 7 April 1966 to Livonia, Michigan

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Livonia, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2009 at Bossier City, Louisiana

Ordered into active military service 28 September 2012 at Bossier City, Louisiana; released from active military service 1 November 2013 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 1 April 2018 at Bossier City, Louisiana; released from active military service 1 April 2019 and reverted to reserve status
