Inactivated 1 December 1945 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Activated 25 August 1947 in the Philippines as the 64th Military Police Company (Philippine Scouts)

Inactivated 1 June 1949 in the Philippines

Allotted 25 February 1953 to the Regular Army

Activated 16 March 1953 in Austria

Inactivated 31 July 1955 in Austria

Activated 27 December 1955 in France

Reorganized and redesignated 15 March 1968 as the 64th Military Police Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1988 as the 64th Military Police Company
