**800th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY**

Constituted 10 March 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 800th Military Police Company

Activated 20 April 1945 in New Guinea

Inactivated 31 May 1946 at Clark Field, Philippines

Activated 25 March 1947 at Baltimore, Maryland, and allotted to the Organized Reserve

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 14 March 1950 as 800th Military Police Company, Post, Camp or Station

Ordered into active military service 27 October 1950 at Baltimore, Maryland

Reorganized and redesignated 25 January 1954 as the 800th Military Police Company

Released from active military service 7 March 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 17 March 1955 to Rockville, Maryland

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Rockville, Maryland; released from active military service 13 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Rockville, Maryland

Activated 16 September 2012 at El Dorado, Arkansas

Ordered into active military service 31 May 2022 at El Dorado, Arkansas; released from active military service 4 July 2023 and reverted to reserve status
