

Lineage and Honors

810th MILITARY POLICE COMPANY

Organized prior to 1925 in the Regular Army at Fort Shafter, Territory of Hawaii, as the Military Police Company, Hawaiian Department

Reorganized and redesignated 24 December 1941 as the 810th Military Police Company

Inactivated 29 June 1946 at Fort Kamehameha, Territory of Hawaii

Withdrawn 27 June 1947 from allotment to the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 July 1947 at Jackson, Mississippi

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 1 November 1949 to Rome, Georgia

Inactivated 25 August 1959 at Rome, Georgia

Activated 22 February 1972 at Clearwater, Florida

Location changed 15 July 1972 to Tampa, Florida

Ordered into active military service 12 September 1990 at Tampa, Florida; released from active military service 12 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 15 March 2003 at Tampa, Florida; released from active military service 15 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status
