Constituted 8 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 822d Military Police Company

Activated 15 November 1944 in Holland

Inactivated 20 January 1947 in Germany

Allotted 11 April 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 28 April 1947 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 4 December 1950 at Chicago, Illinois

Activated 22 February 1972 at Chicago, Illinois

Location changed 16 October 1979 to Rosemont, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 3 January 1991 at Rosemont, Illinois; released from active military service 25 August 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 June 1999 to Arlington Heights, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 27 December 2002 at Arlington Heights, Illinois; released from active military service 9 April 2004 and reverted to reserve status
