Constituted 26 September 1975 in the Kentucky Army National Guard as the 118th Maintenance Company

Organized and Federally recognized 1 November 1975 at Burlington

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1976 as the 130th Maintenance Company

Location changed 1 April 1976 to Hebron; by 1 September 1988 to Walton

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1994 as Detachment 1, 307th Maintenance Company

Reorganized and redesignated 11 October 1995 as the 207th Maintenance Company

Consolidated 1 September 2008 with Detachment 2, 207th Maintenance Company (organized and Federally recognized 29 November 2007 at Brandenburg), and consolidated unit designated as the 203d Support Company; concurrently, location changed to Brandenburg

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2011 as the 1103d Military Police Detachment

Ordered into active Federal service 5 May 2013; released from active Federal service 8 June 2014 and reverted to state control

Location changed 1 October 2014 to Fort Knox; on 31 August 2019 to Greenville

Reorganized and redesignated 2 September 2023 as the 940th Military Police Company; concurrently, location changed to Walton
